Return To School Plan | September 2020

Phases 1 - 3 | Online

- ◆ No in-person instruction, online learning only
- ◆ Food distribution on Tuesdays and Fridays from 12-1 pm.
- ◆ No athletics or extracurricular clubs.
- ◆ Counseling services for students will be available as needed provided by our K-12 counselor and school social worker.
- ◆ Students will be assessed and graded on their academic performance during online learning.
- ◆ If internet is not available, paper packets will be provided.
- ◆ Online learning will require significant parental involvement including monitoring, guidance, and communication with teaching staff.
- ◆ Attendance is monitored and tracked on a daily basis.

We hope this finds you well. We have been busy preparing for a return to school with our Return To School Team. I'm grateful for the efforts of our staff & community members who have helped us progress this far, it has been a team effort.

We are prepared for online and in-person instruction for the fall. We are currently in Phase 5 of the Return to School Roadmap laid out by the Governor & her team. This means we can return to school face to face, with precautions. You will find what is included in each phase within this flyer. **Please note, this is all subject to change within the state at any given moment.**

We are also offering an Online Learning Option (OL). Families must commit to a semester of face to face or OL by Monday, August 17, 2020.

Phase 4 | In-Person

- ◆ In-person instruction is permitted with required safety protocols.
- ◆ Breakfast & lunch services will be provided. All students will eat in their classroom cohort.
- ◆ Athletics will follow MHSAA and NFHS guidelines.
- ◆ Counseling services for students will be available as needed provided by our K-12 counselor and school social worker.
- ◆ Busing will be provided. School personnel and students will be required to wear a mask while on the bus. Due to limited seating, students will need to preregister for riding the bus.
- ◆ All school personnel will be required to wear a mask except during meal times.
- ◆ All students 6-12 will be required to wear a mask except during meal times or during P.E.
- ◆ All students preK-5 will be required to wear a mask in common areas in the building such as the hallway, bathrooms, etc when leaving their cohort.

- ◆ Parents may choose to have their child wear their mask all day, that is their choice.
- ◆ Increased cleaning and handwashing.
- ◆ No sharing of materials.
- ◆ All screening, testing, and responding to positive tests for COVID-19 will cooperate with the local Health Department protocols.

Online Learning (OL)

- ◆ OL students must commit to at least one semester of online learning before returning to In-person learning
- ◆ OL students should expect to spend a full school day engaged in online learning.
- ◆ OL students will be scheduled into OL electives/essentials by our counselor. The choices provided will be based on the course catalog of Accelerated Ed and may not match in-person elective offerings.
- ◆ OL will require significant parental involvement including monitoring, guidance, and communication with teaching staff.
- ◆ Attendance is monitored and tracked on a daily basis.

Phase 5 | In-Person

- ◆ In-person instruction is permitted with required safety protocols.
- ◆ Breakfast & lunch services will be provided. All students will eat in their classroom cohort.
- ◆ Athletics will follow MHSAA and NFHS guidelines.
- ◆ Counseling services for students will be available as needed provided by our K-12 counselor and school social worker.
- ◆ Busing will be provided. School personnel and students will be required to wear a mask while on the bus. Due to limited seating, students will need to preregister for riding the bus.
- ◆ All school staff will be required to wear a mask except during meal times or when not with their cohort or when they can't social distance at 6 ft apart.
- ◆ All students 6-12 will be required to wear a mask except during meal times or when not with their cohort or when they can't social distance at 6 ft apart.
- ◆ All students preK-5 will be required to wear a mask in common areas in the building such as the hallway, bathrooms, etc when leaving their cohort. Parents may choose to have their child wear their mask all day, that is their choice.
- ◆ When staff or students are in different cohorts, masks will be worn by all.
- ◆ Each teacher can require students, when in their classroom, to wear a mask; even if it is possible to maintain physical distance minimums.
