

## Highly Qualified Information

School Year: 2015-2016

Dear Parent or Guardian,

According to a law called *No Child Left Behind*, we are required to send notice to parents concerning teacher qualifications.

Because your child attends a school that receives federal funds from a program called Title I, the law says you may receive the following information about the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher(s):

1. If the teacher has met Michigan licensing requirements and certification for the grade level(s) and subject area(s) instructing. *(All of our teachers are fully certified and licensed in Michigan for the grades and subjects that they teach. **This information meets the intent of this law.**)*
2. If the teacher is teaching under an emergency permit or other special circumstance and Michigan licensing requirements have been waived. *(We have no special certification circumstances for K-8<sup>th</sup> teachers, and all of our teachers are Highly Qualified. However, we do have one Career Tech teachers at the high school level that have a special Annual Vocational Authorization to teach. **This information meets the intent of this law.**)*
3. The teacher's college degrees and major area of study.

You may also request highly qualified information about any paraprofessional providing Title I services to your child. *(All of our academic paraprofessionals are Highly Qualified as required by the federal law No Child Left Behind. **This information meets the intent of this law.**)*
