Millage Renewal Proposal: 0.75 mill for 4 years

*If approved, to be levied by Char-Em ISD
for all 11 local public school districts.*

How much is 0.75 mill?

0.75 of a mill is equal to approx. \$75 per year for a home with a taxable value of \$100,000.

Proposal for renewal of area-wide Career and Technical Education millage:

"This proposal will allow the continued levy by the Intermediate School District of millage for Career and Technical Education previously approved by the electors.

Shall the limitation on the annual property tax rate for Career and Technical Education in Charlevoix-Emmet Intermediate School District, Michigan, be increased by 0.75 mill for a period of 4 years, 2018 to 2021...?" Full ballot proposal language: charemisd.org
